
Bankruptcy filings are always extremely light during the week that includes the July 4 holiday, and last week was no exception. The 5,274 bankruptcy cases filed last week represented the lowest weekly total since January 2022.


Chapter 7 filings continue to fall from prior years, while chapter 13 filings are up substantially from the first two years of the pandemic — but well below pre-pandemic levels.




The following charts show recent weekly filing trends by chapter compared to 2021, 2020 and 2019.

Chapter 11 Cases

The 64 chapter 11 cases filed last week were well below the total for the same week during the last two years. Even excluding related cases by corporate subsidiaries, filings were well below the first two years of the pandemic.

There were two notable chapter 11 filings during the week, both in the Southern District of New York. SAS AB, the national airline of Denmark, Norway and Sweden, filed along with 13 related entities on July 5. Also on July 5, Crypto lender Voyager Digital Holdings, Inc. filed along with two related entities.
