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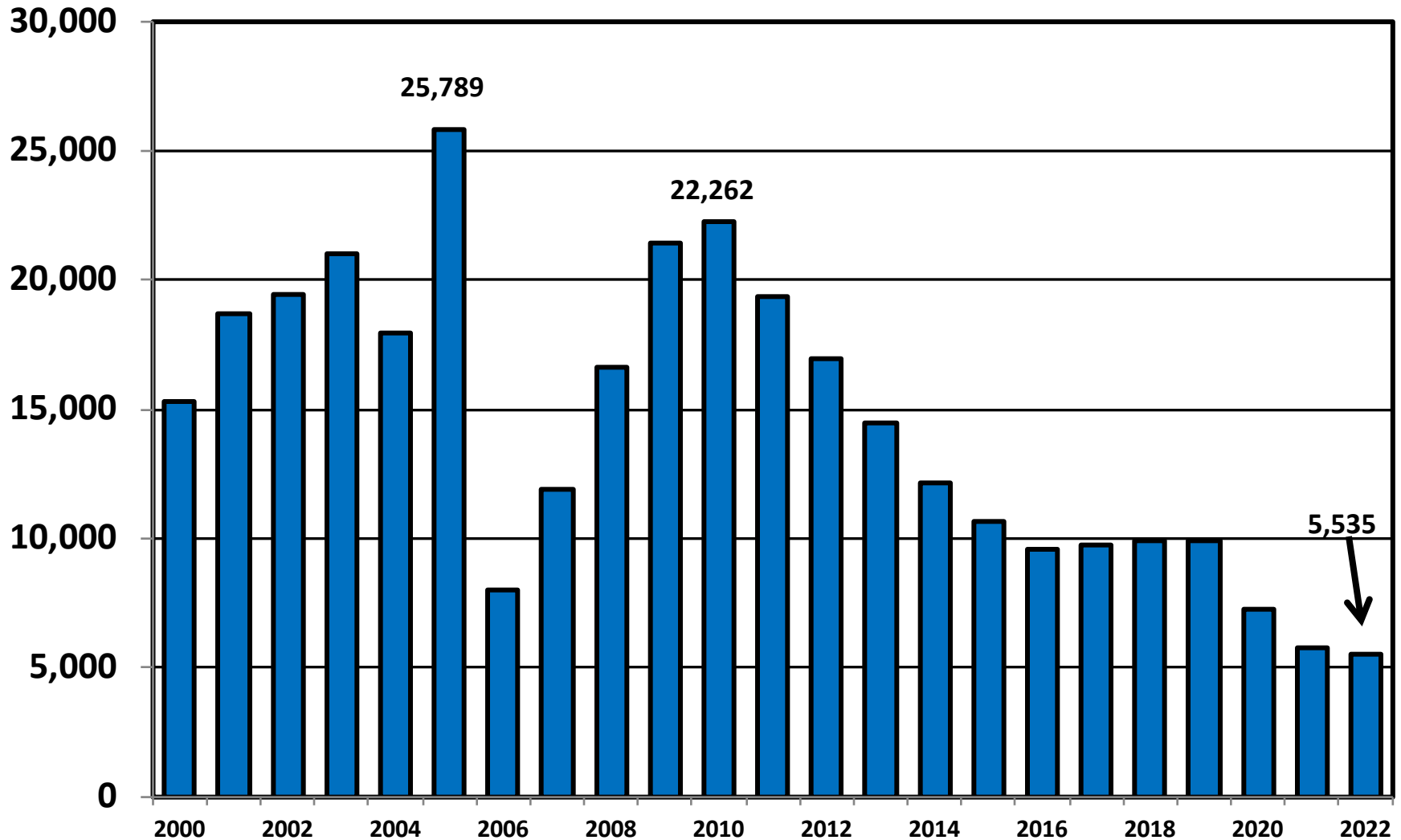

Total Filings Relative to Population 2000 - 2022



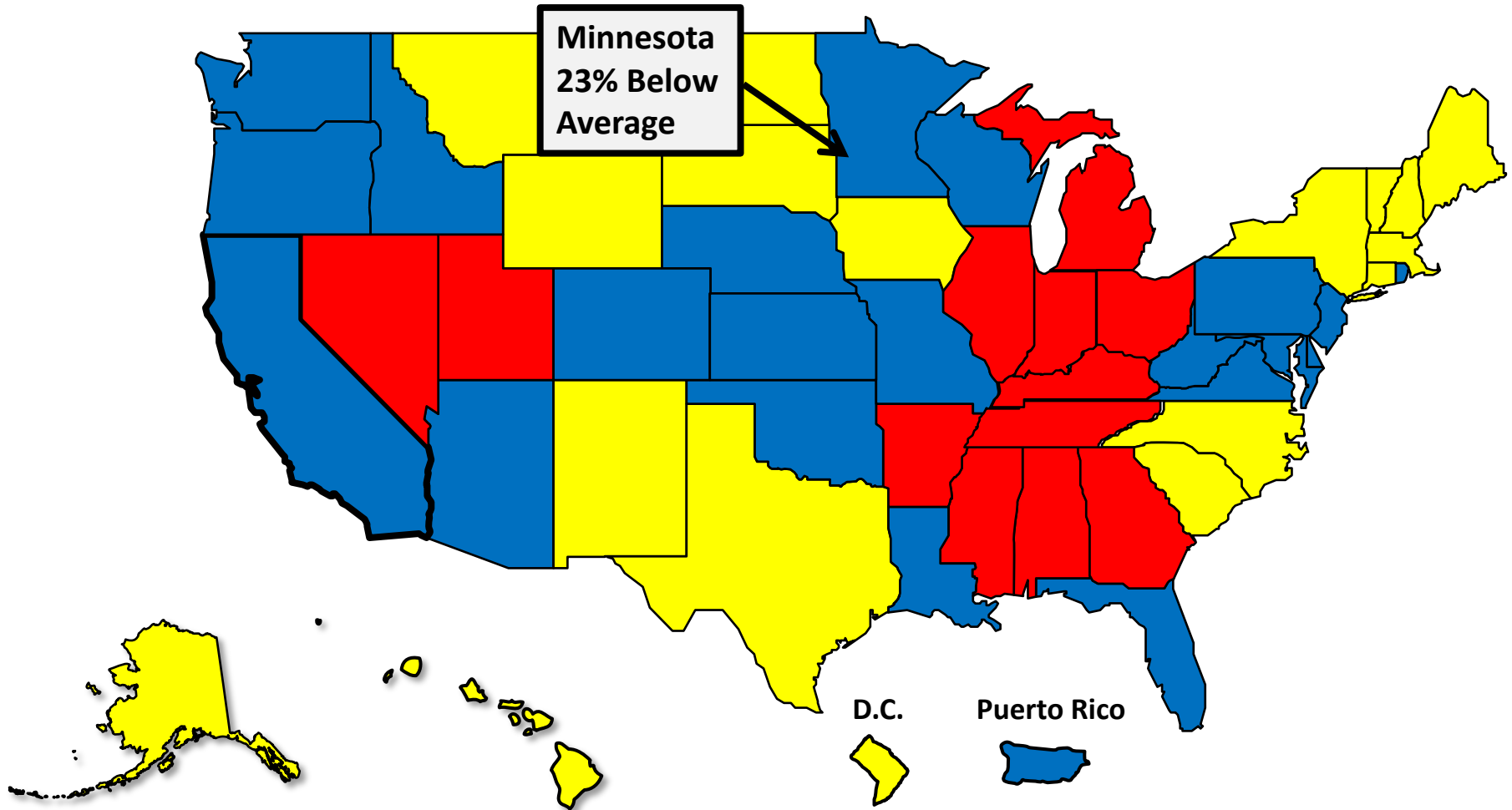

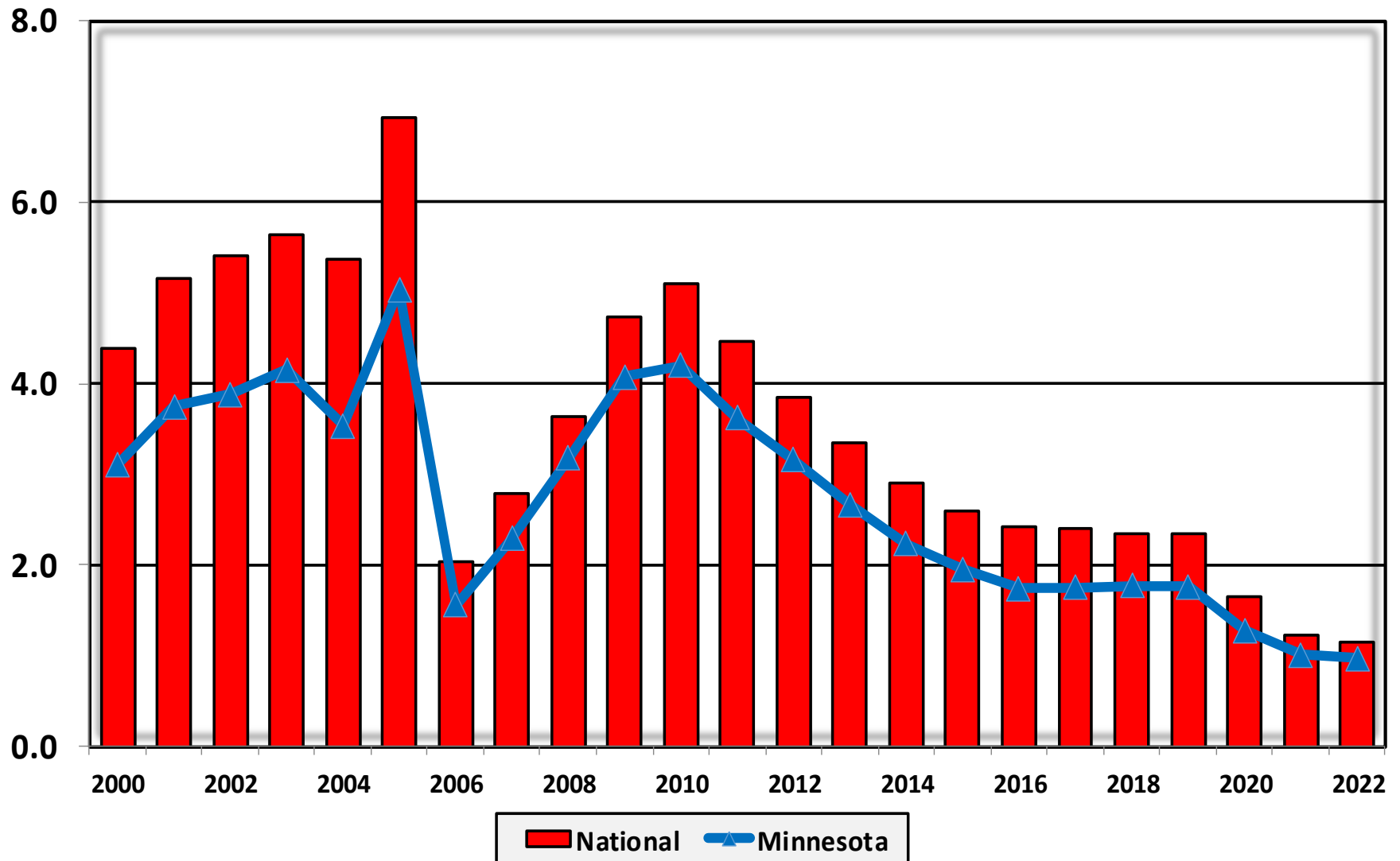

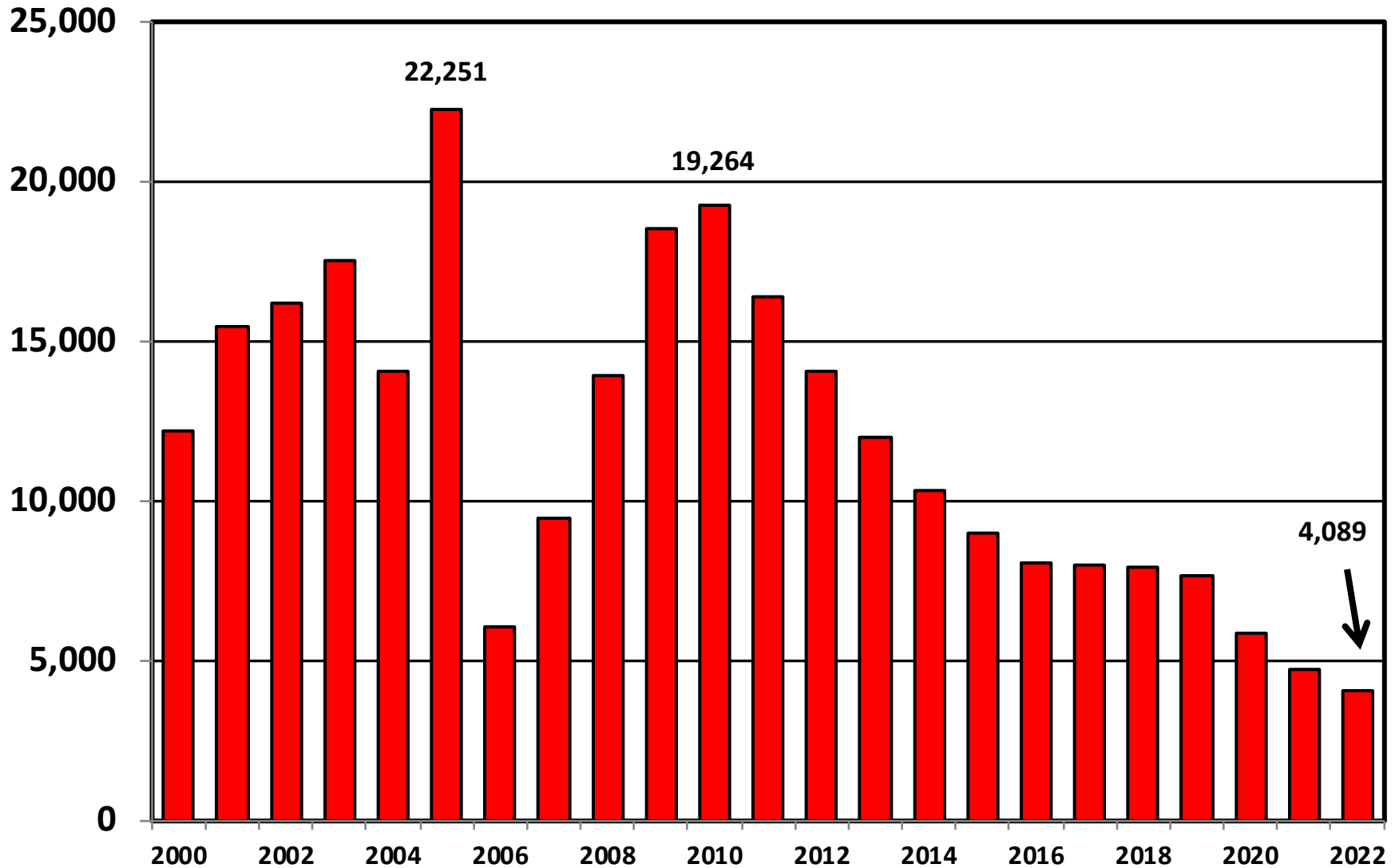


Bankruptcy Filings per 1,000 Population Minnesota vs. National Average 2000 - 2022

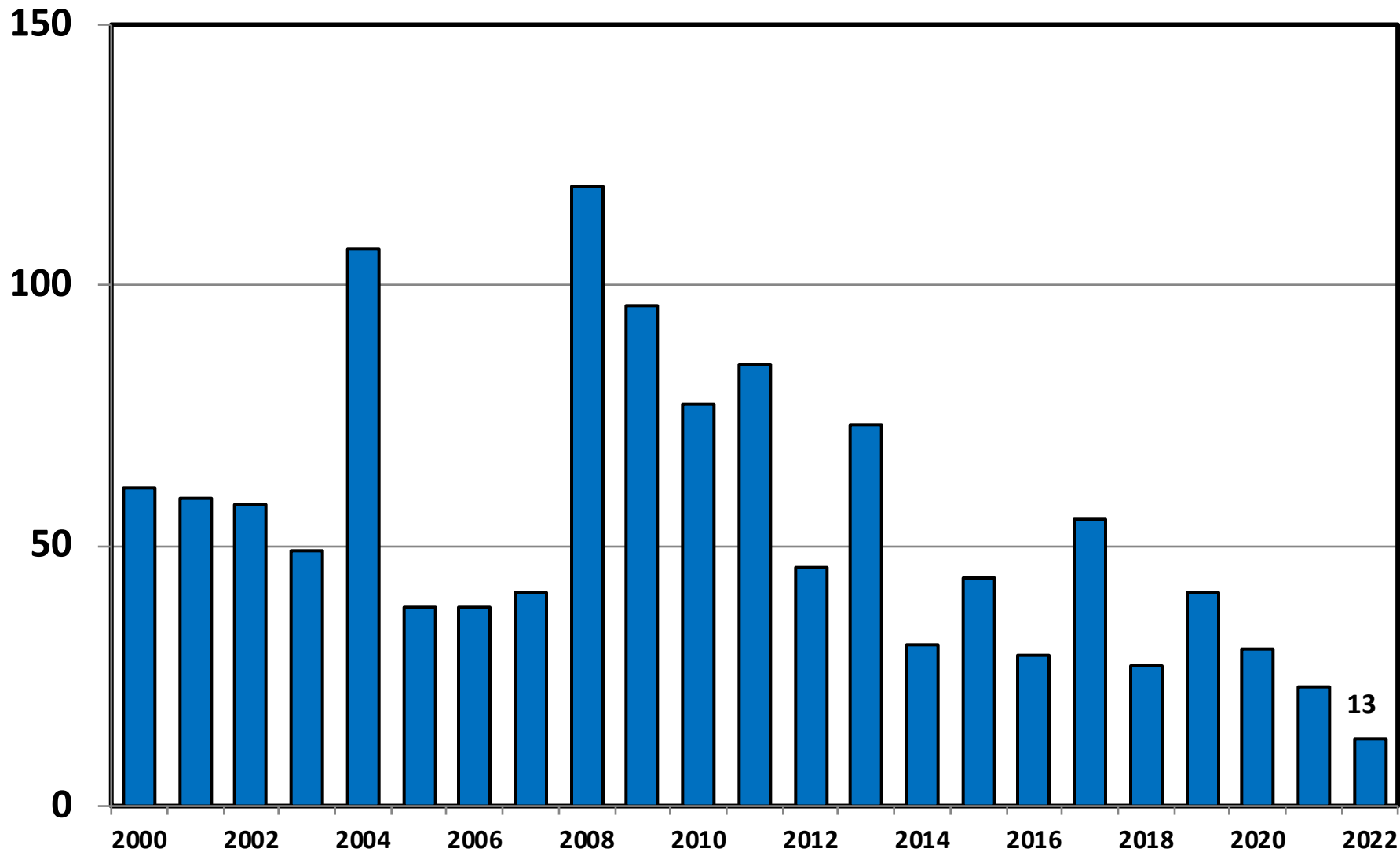

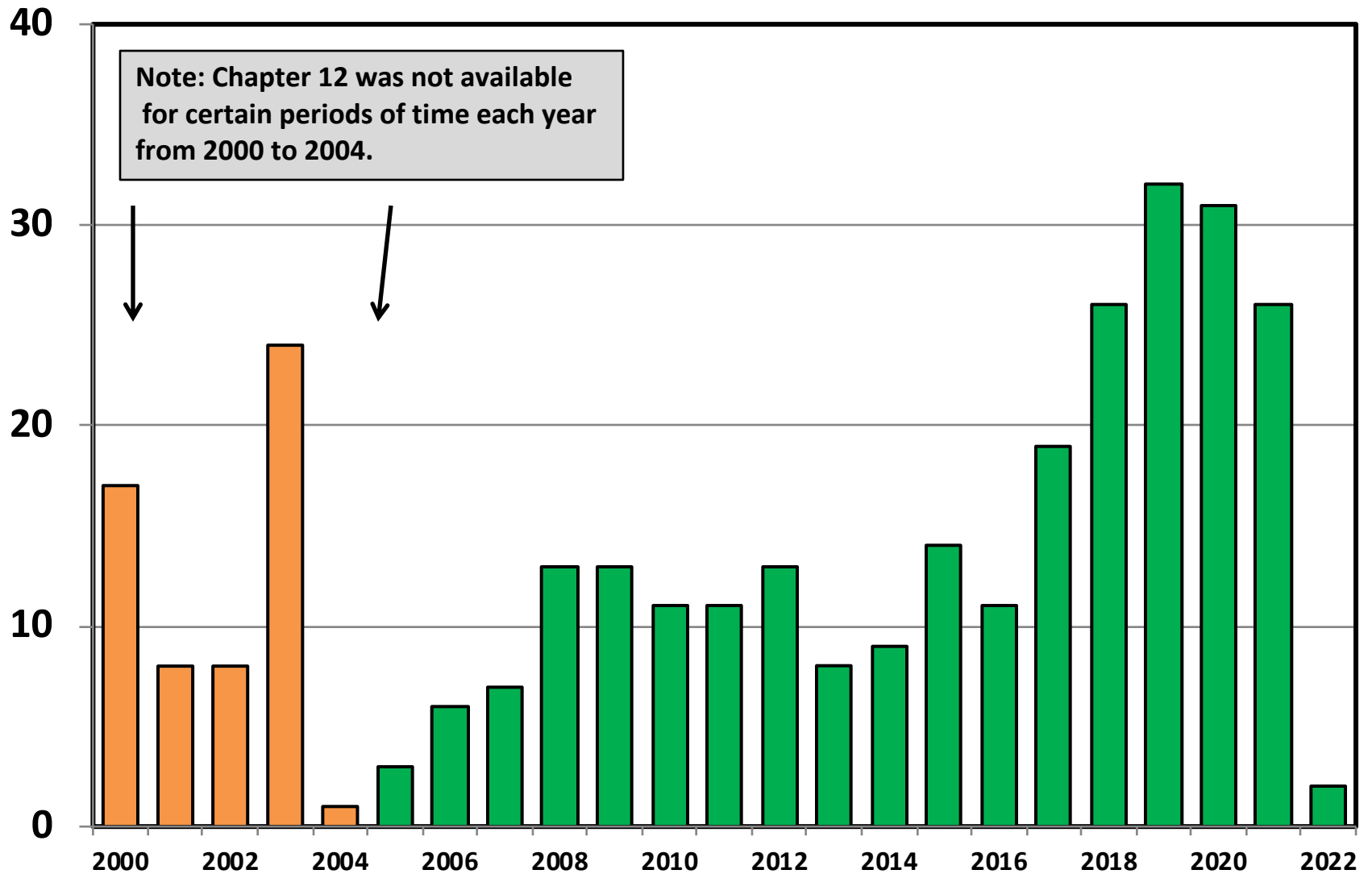

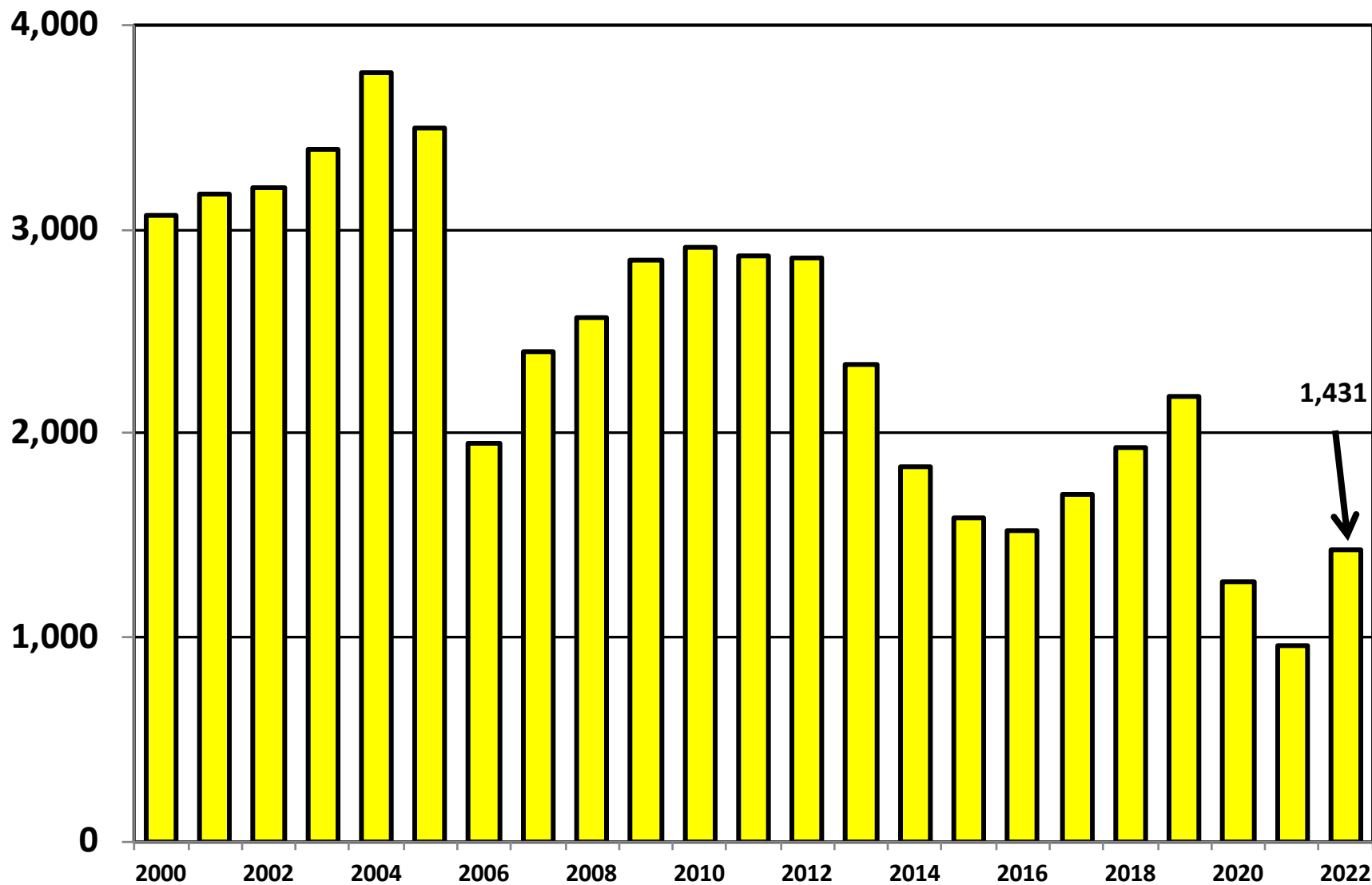
Chapter 11 Cases Filed in Minnesota 2000 - 2022



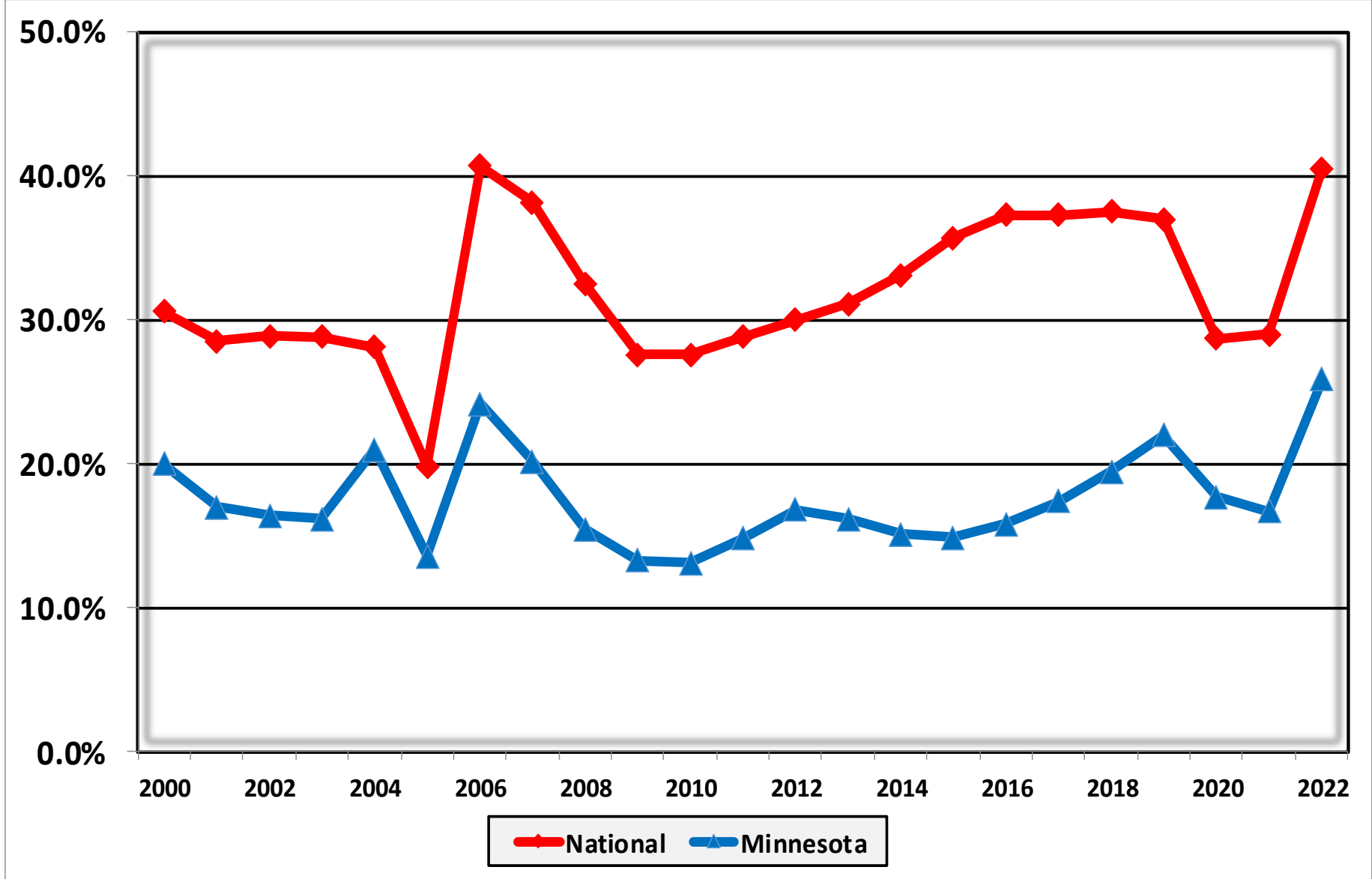

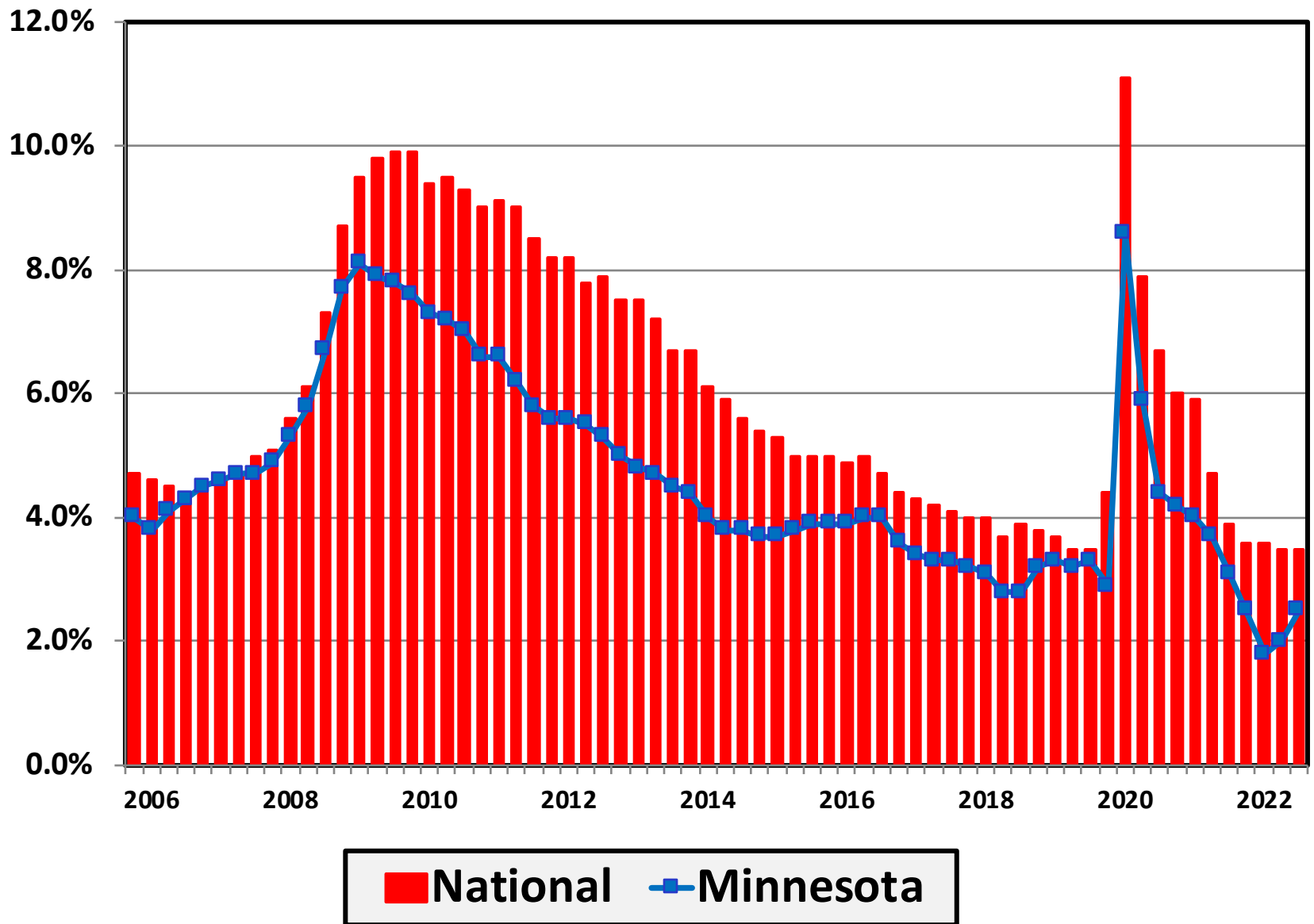

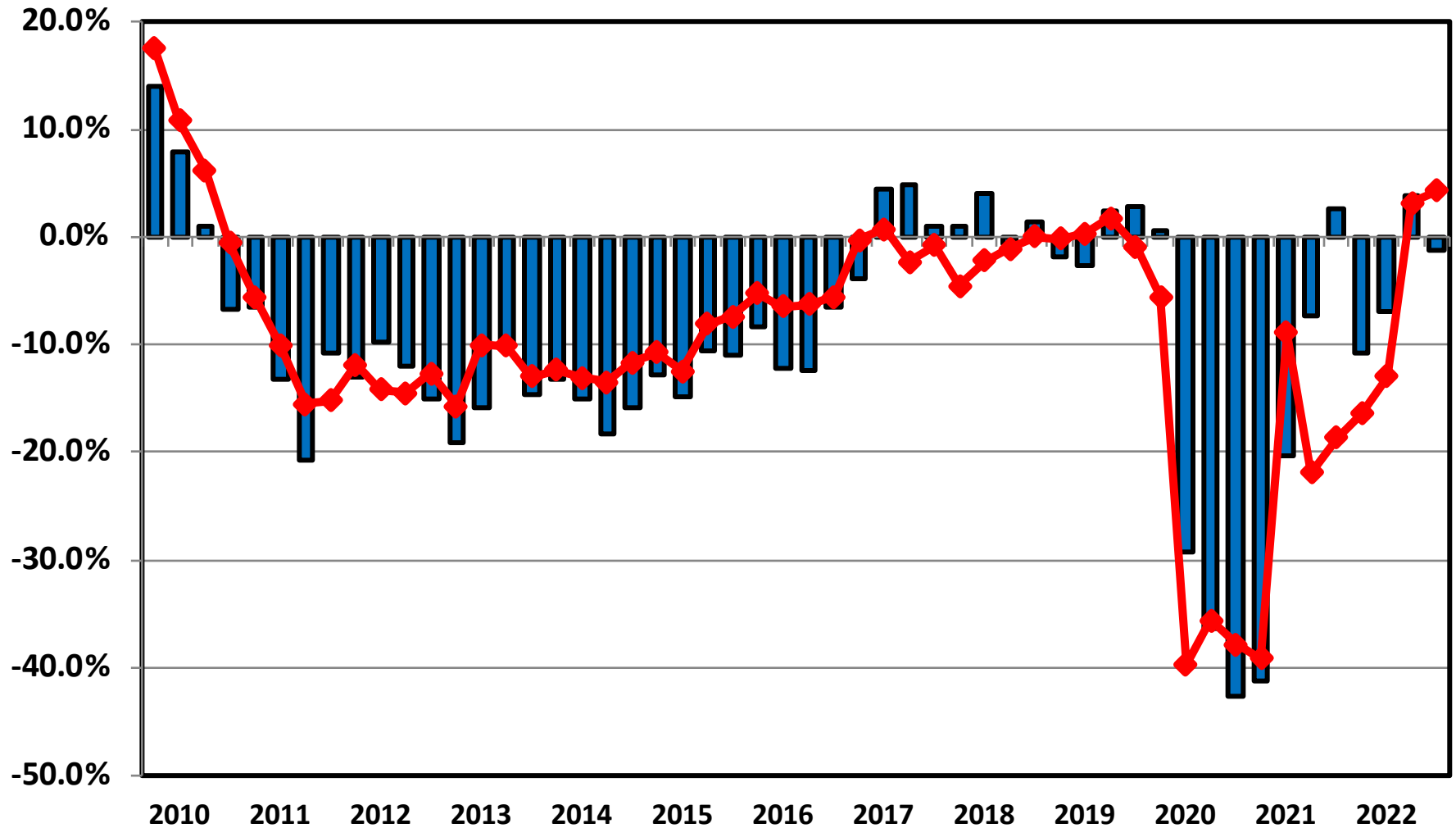


Unemployment Rate By Quarter 2006 - 2022

Filing Trends By Quarter Minnesota vs. National Average (Percent Change From Same Quarter One Year Prior)

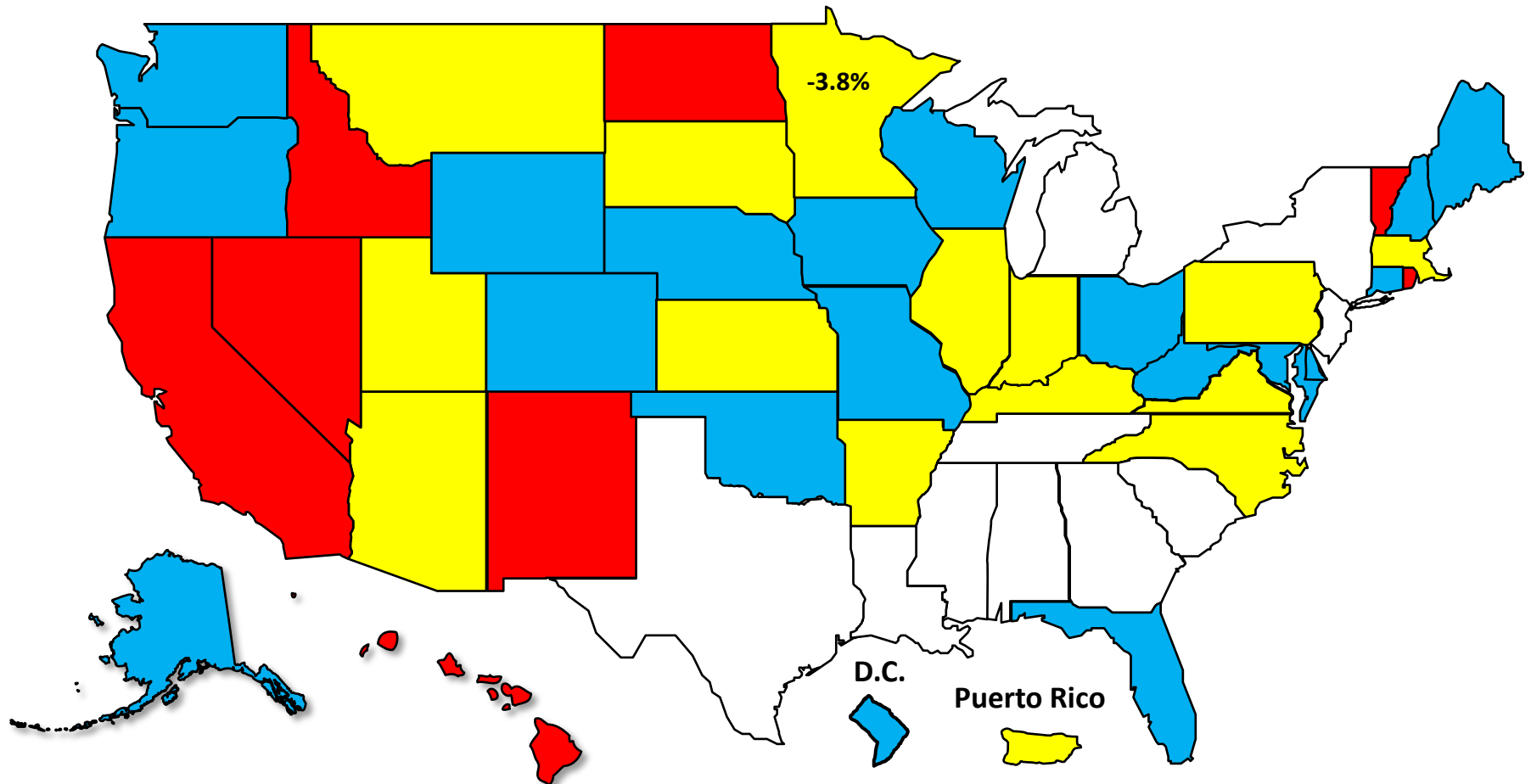
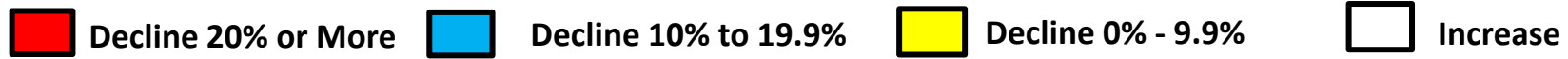

National Average = 6.3% Decrease

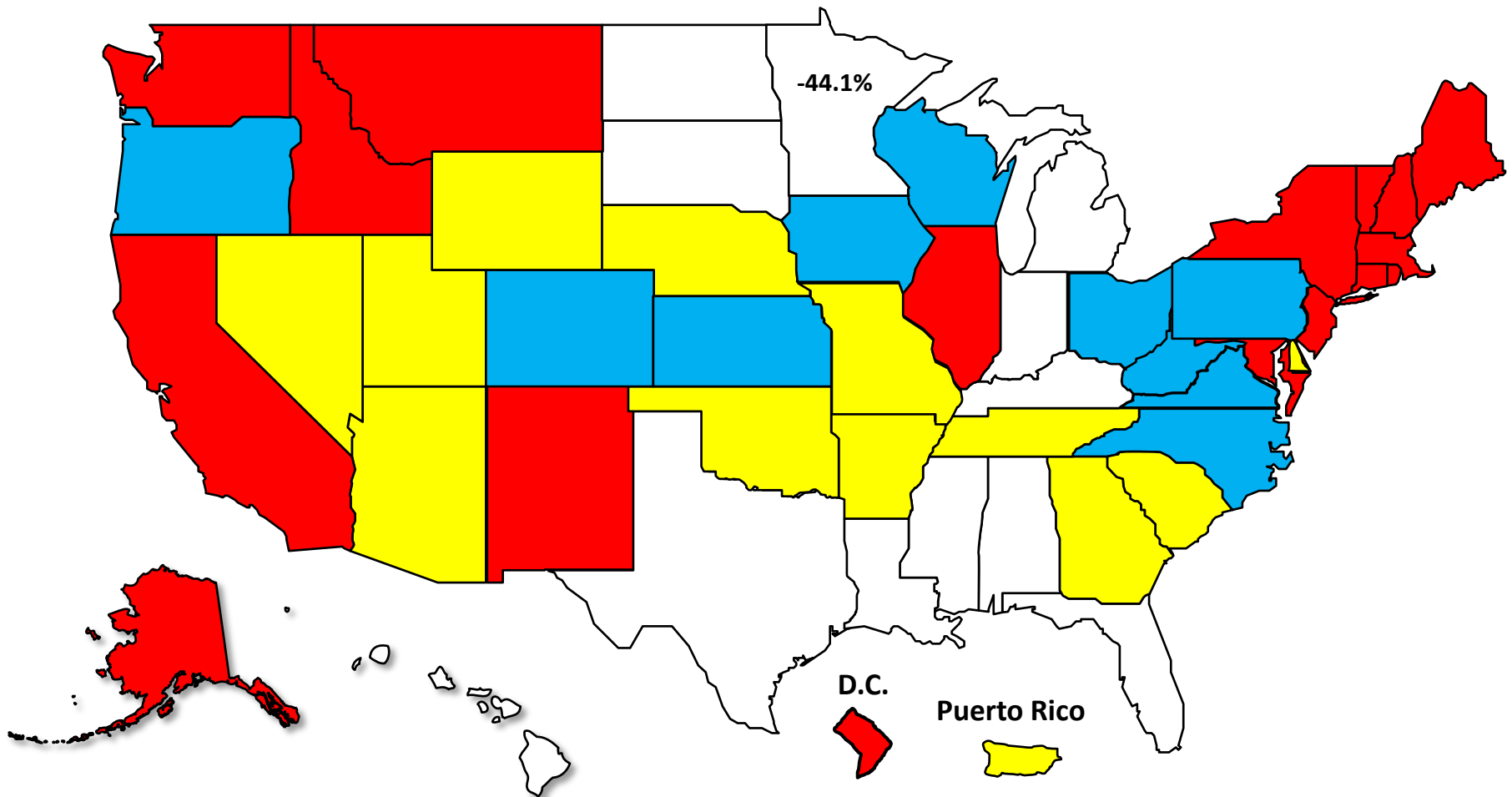


Bankruptcy Filing Trends During the Pandemic

National Average = 50.0% Decrease

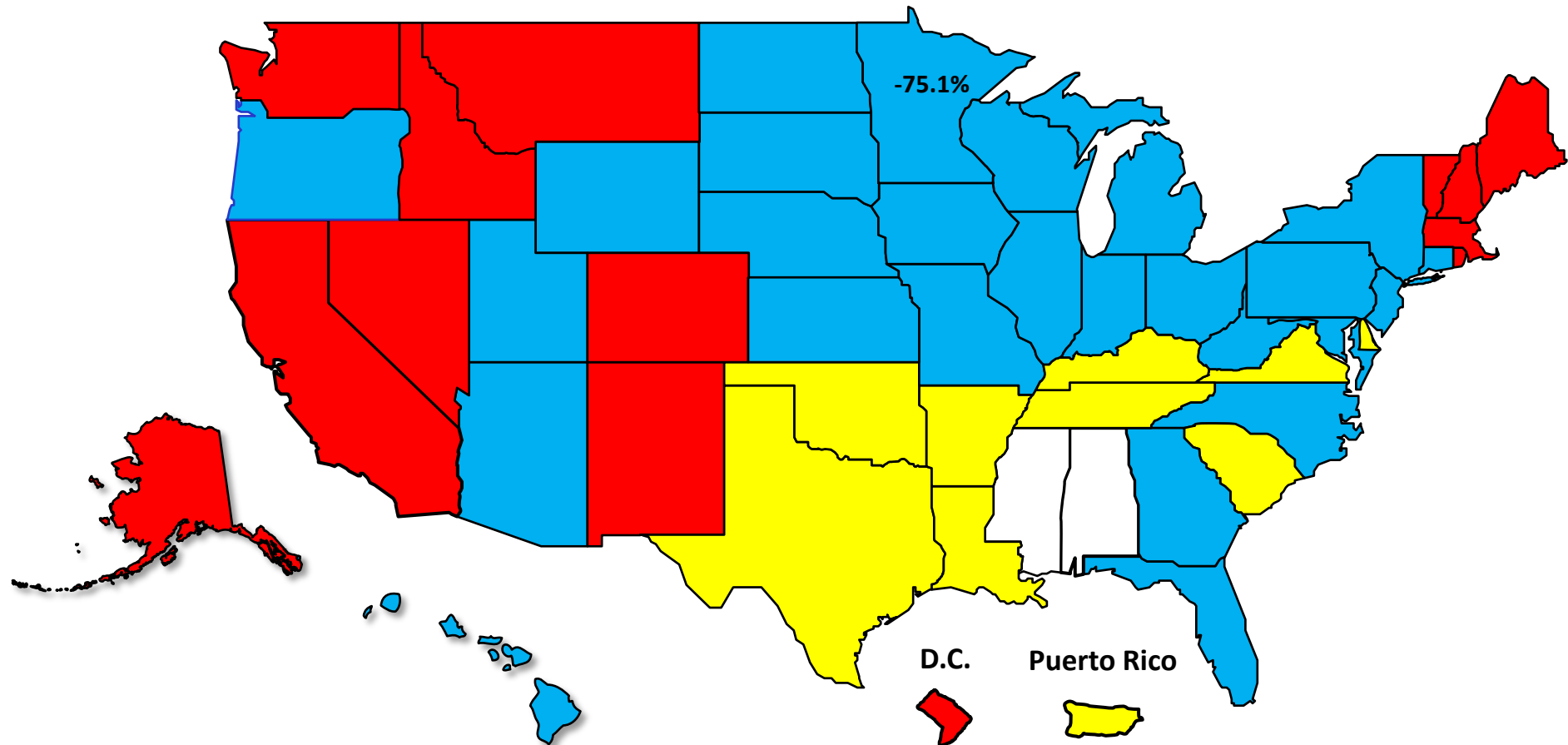
Decline Under 45% Decline 45.0% – 49.9% Decline 50.0% – 54.9% Decline 55% or More
