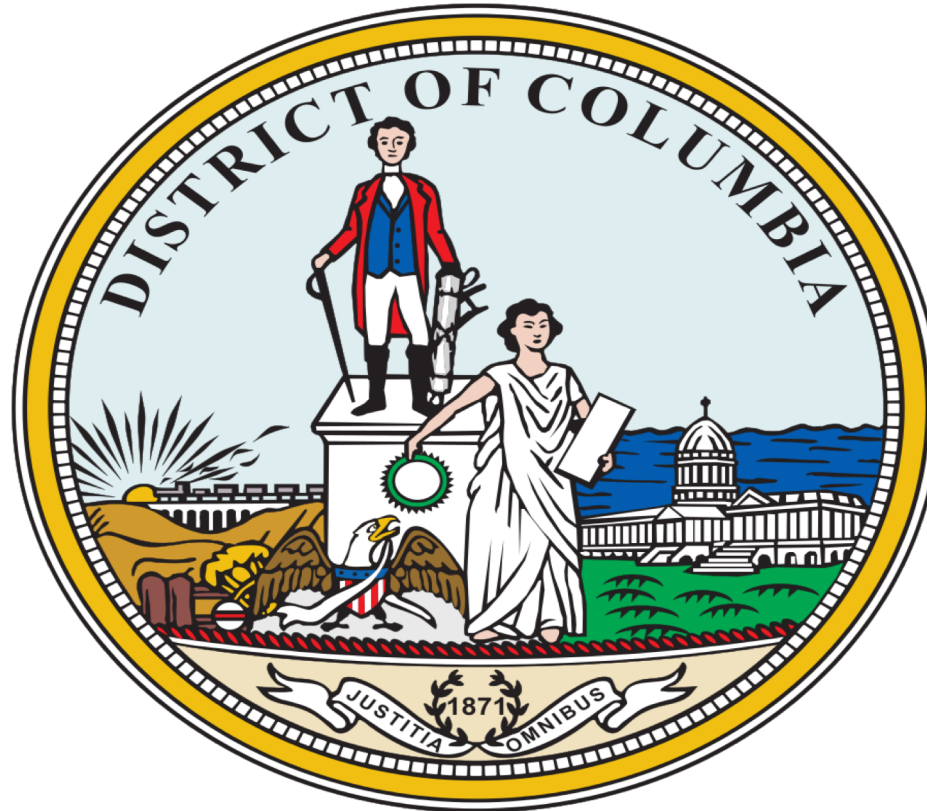

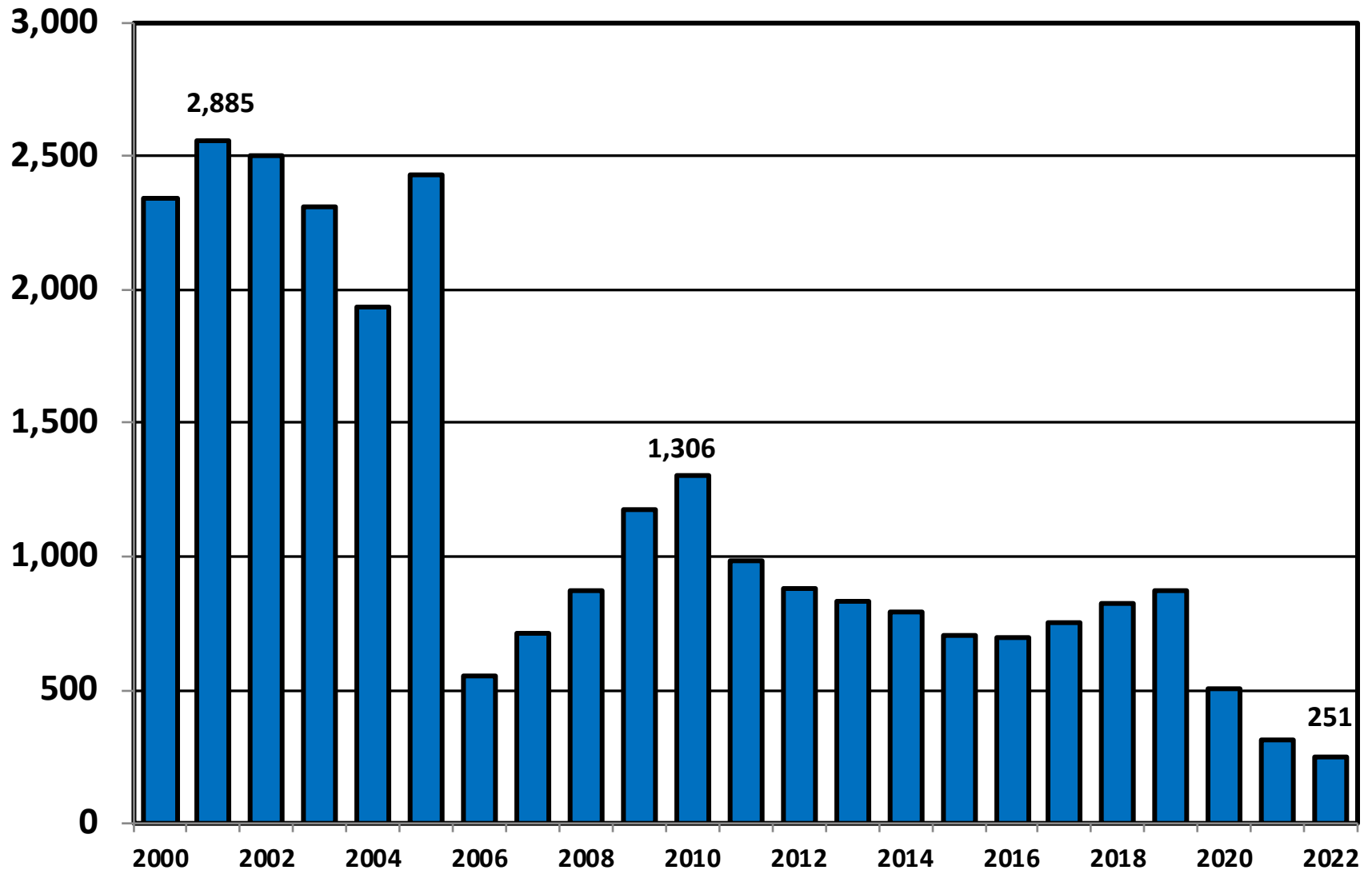

Total Filings Relative to Population 2000 - 2022



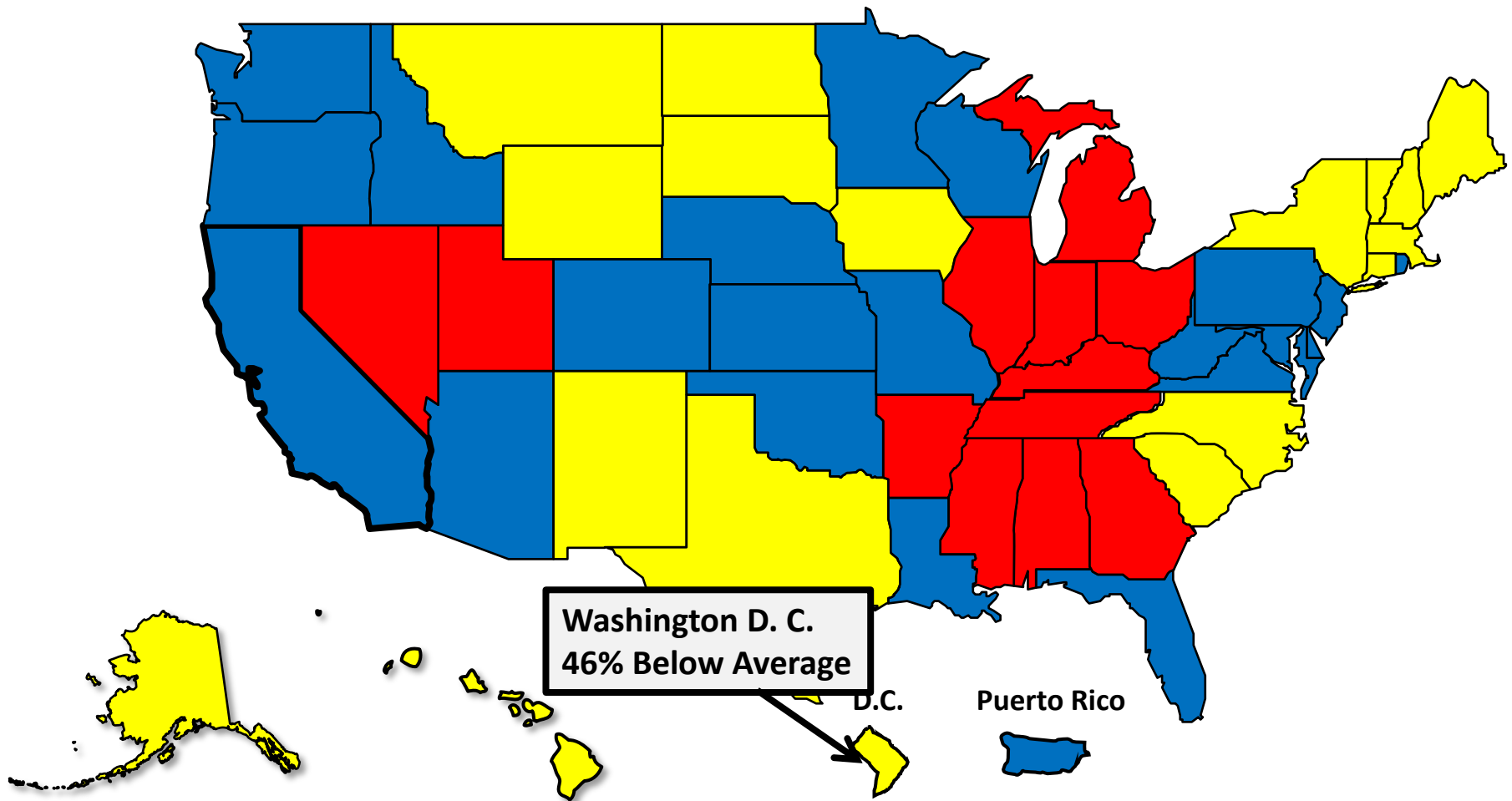

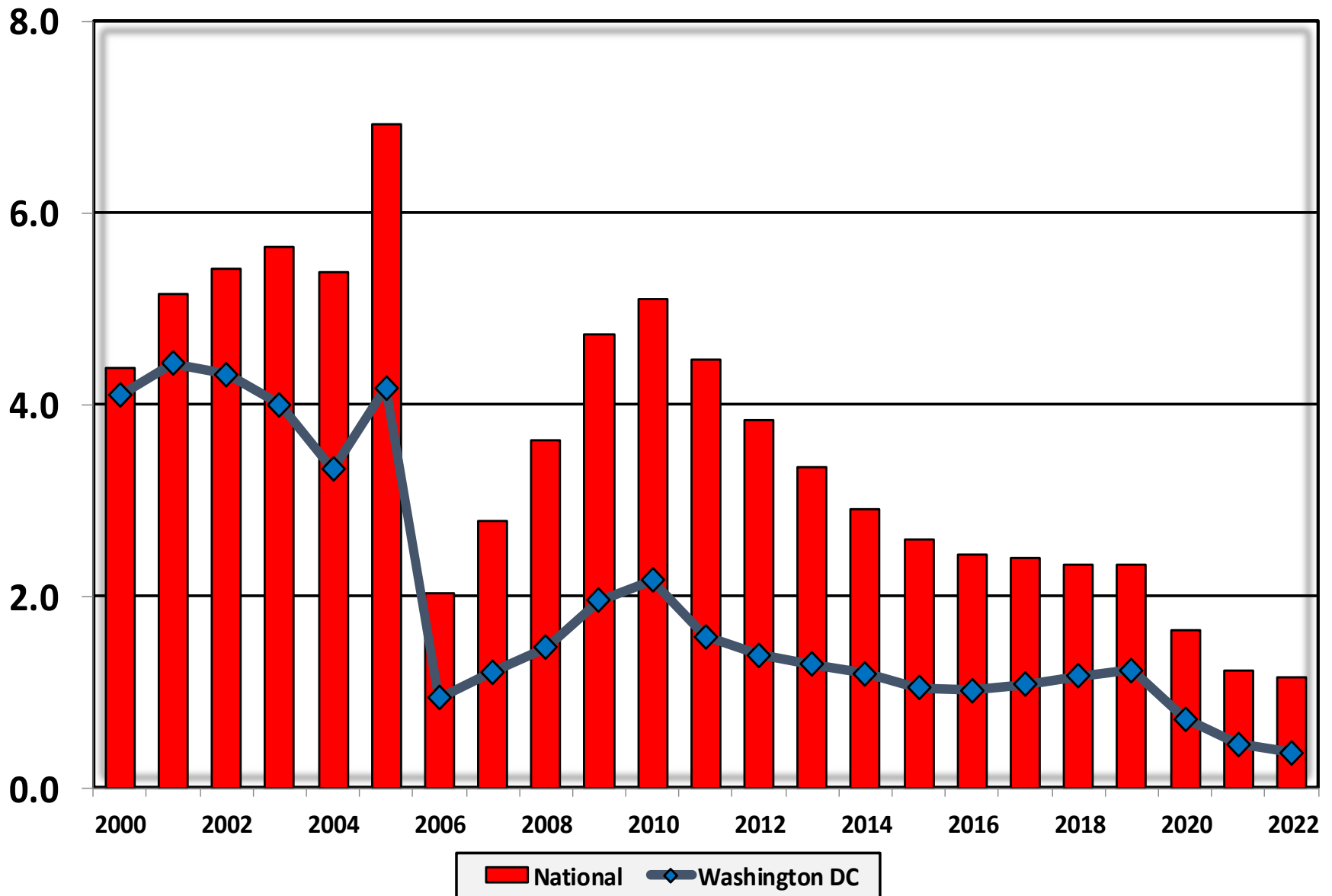

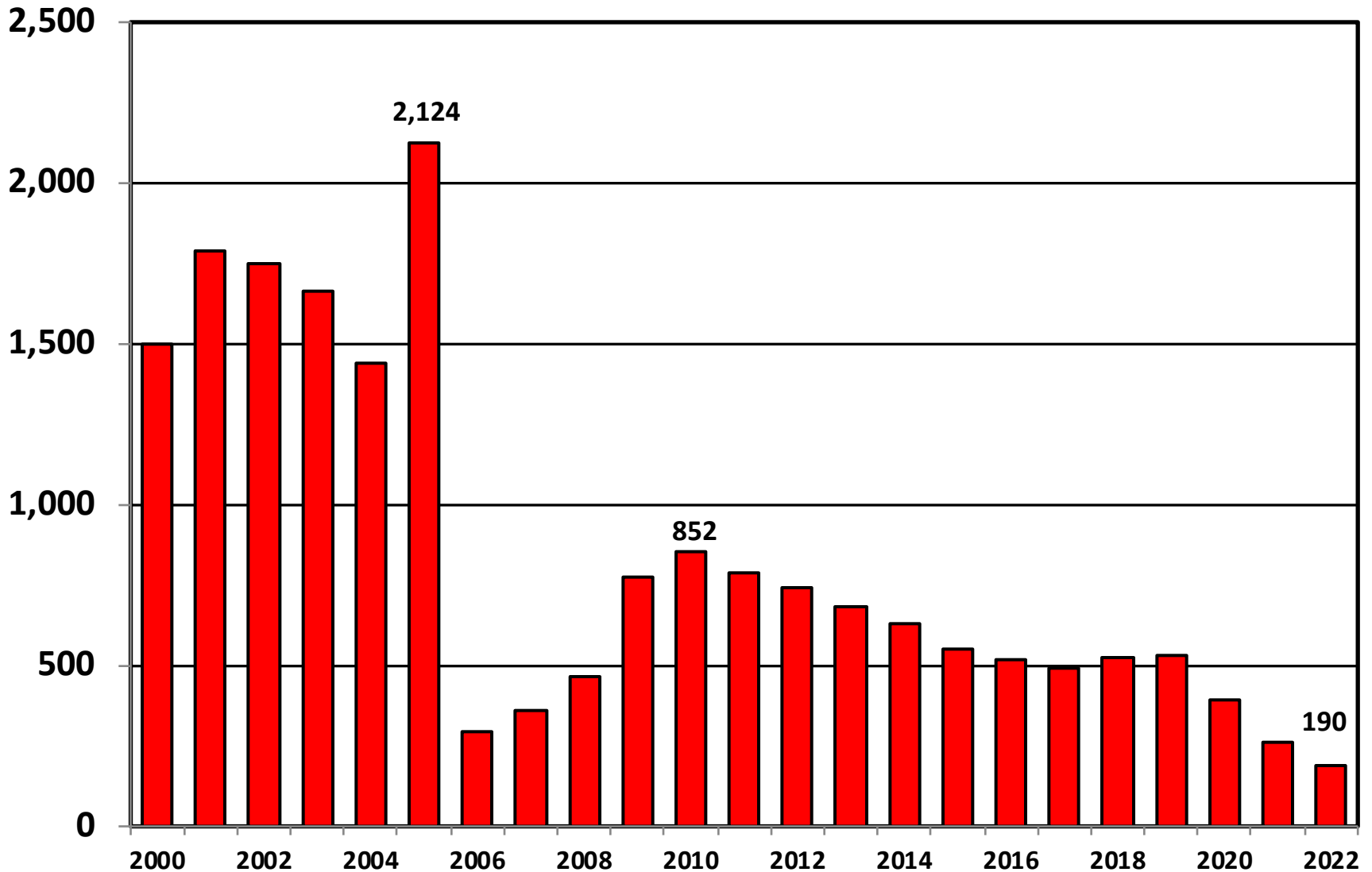
Bankruptcy Filings per 1,000 Population

Washington D.C. vs. National Average 2000 - 2022

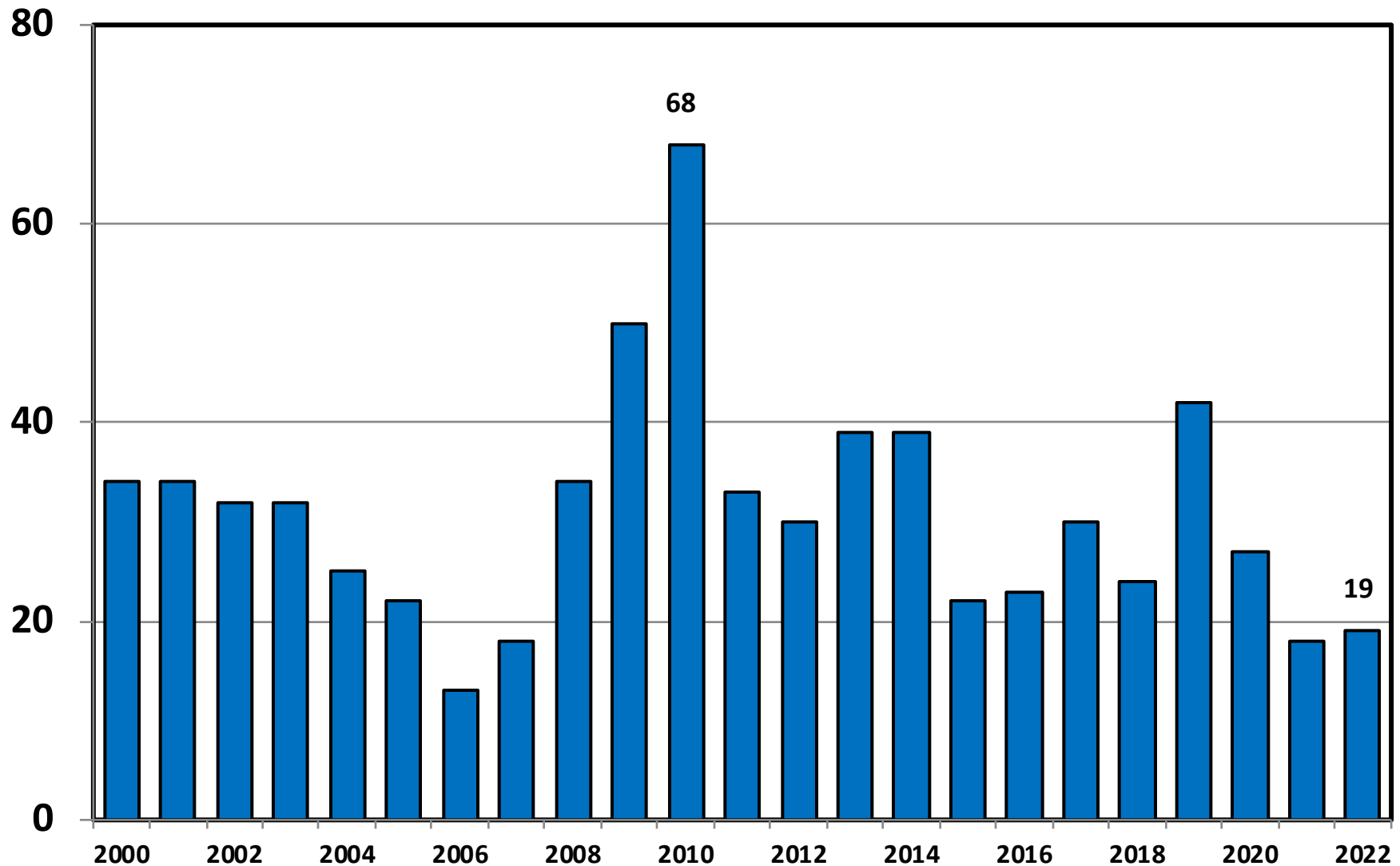

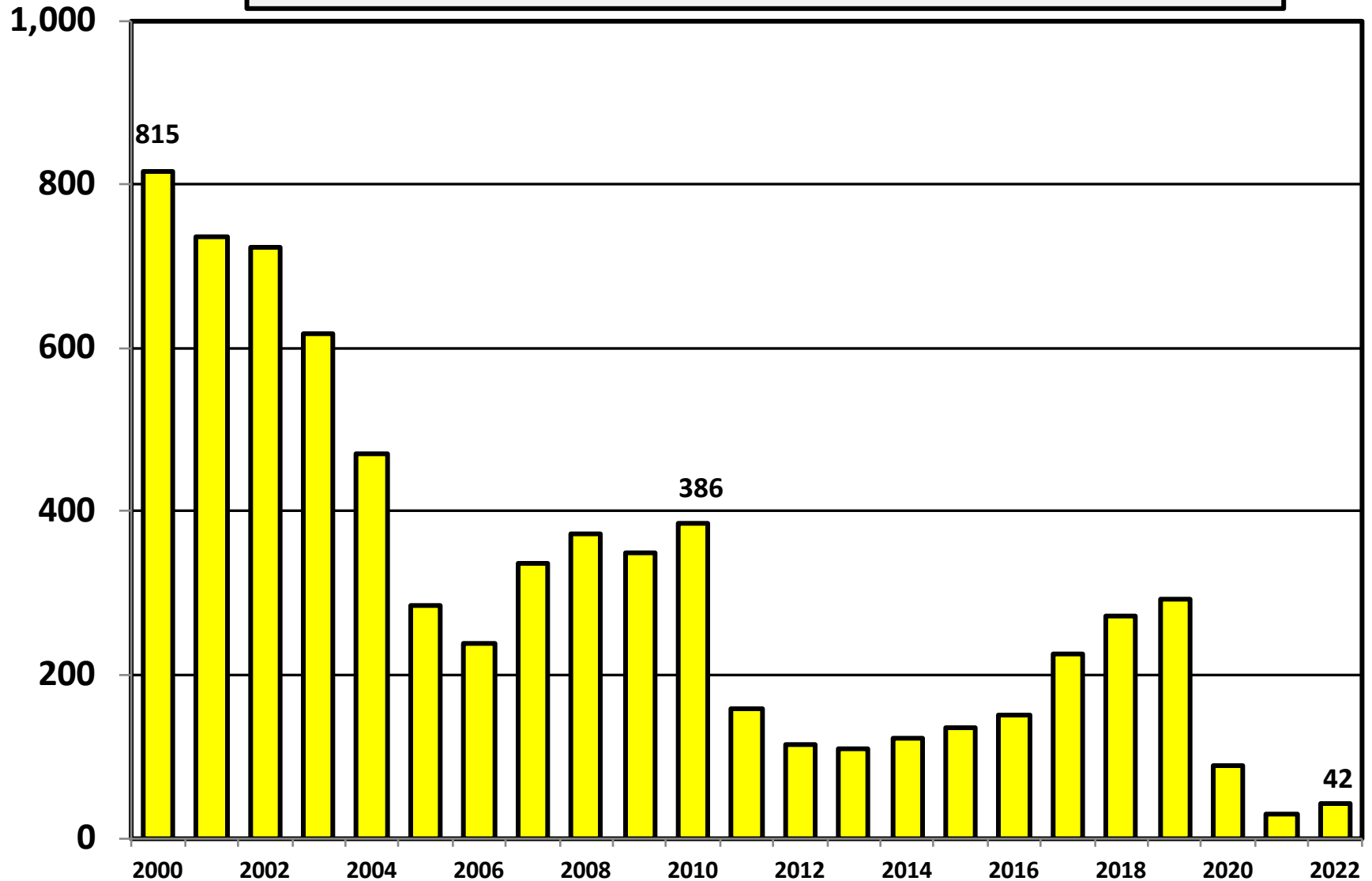

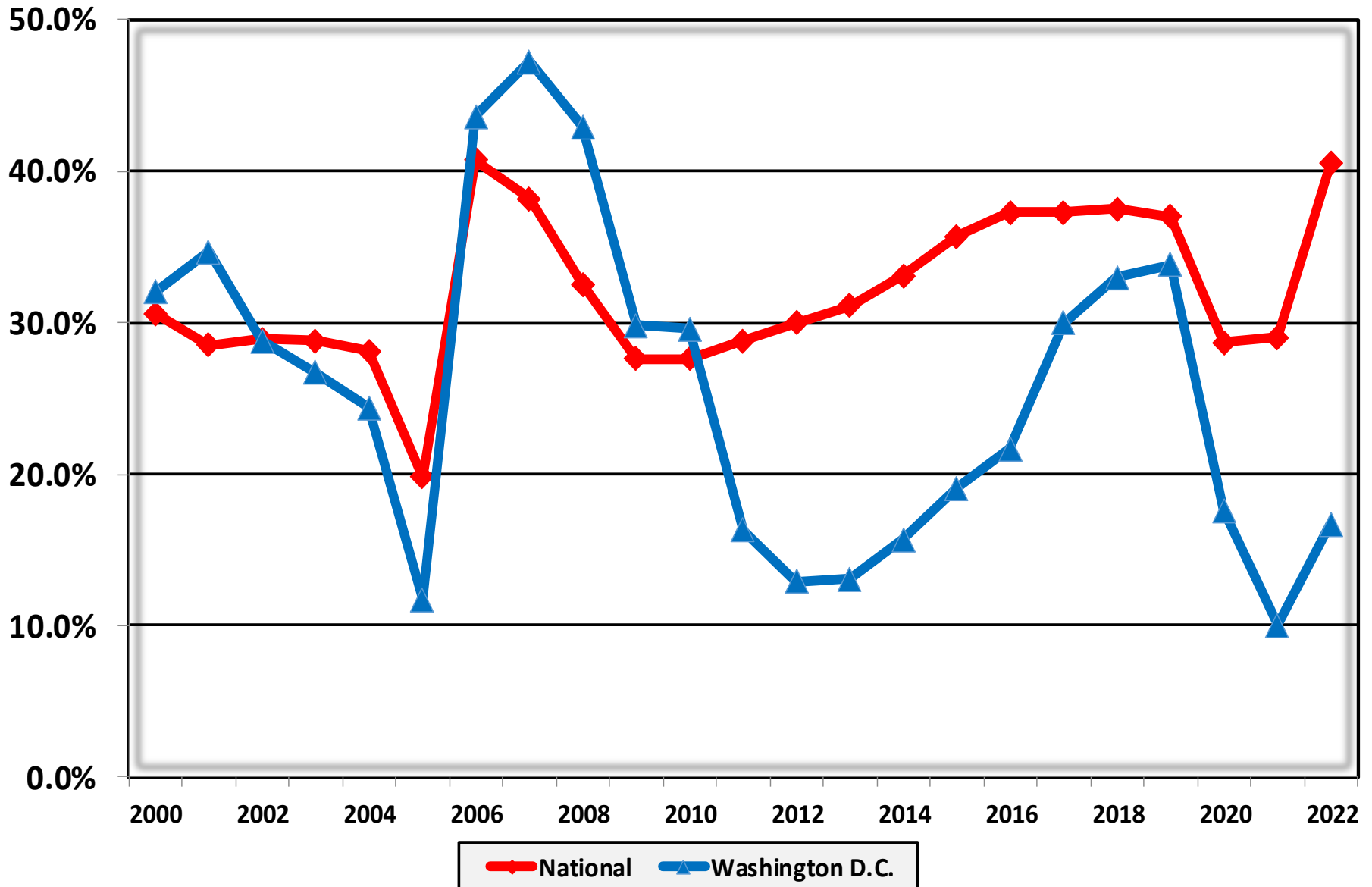
Chapter 11 Cases Filed in Washington D.C. 2000 - 2022



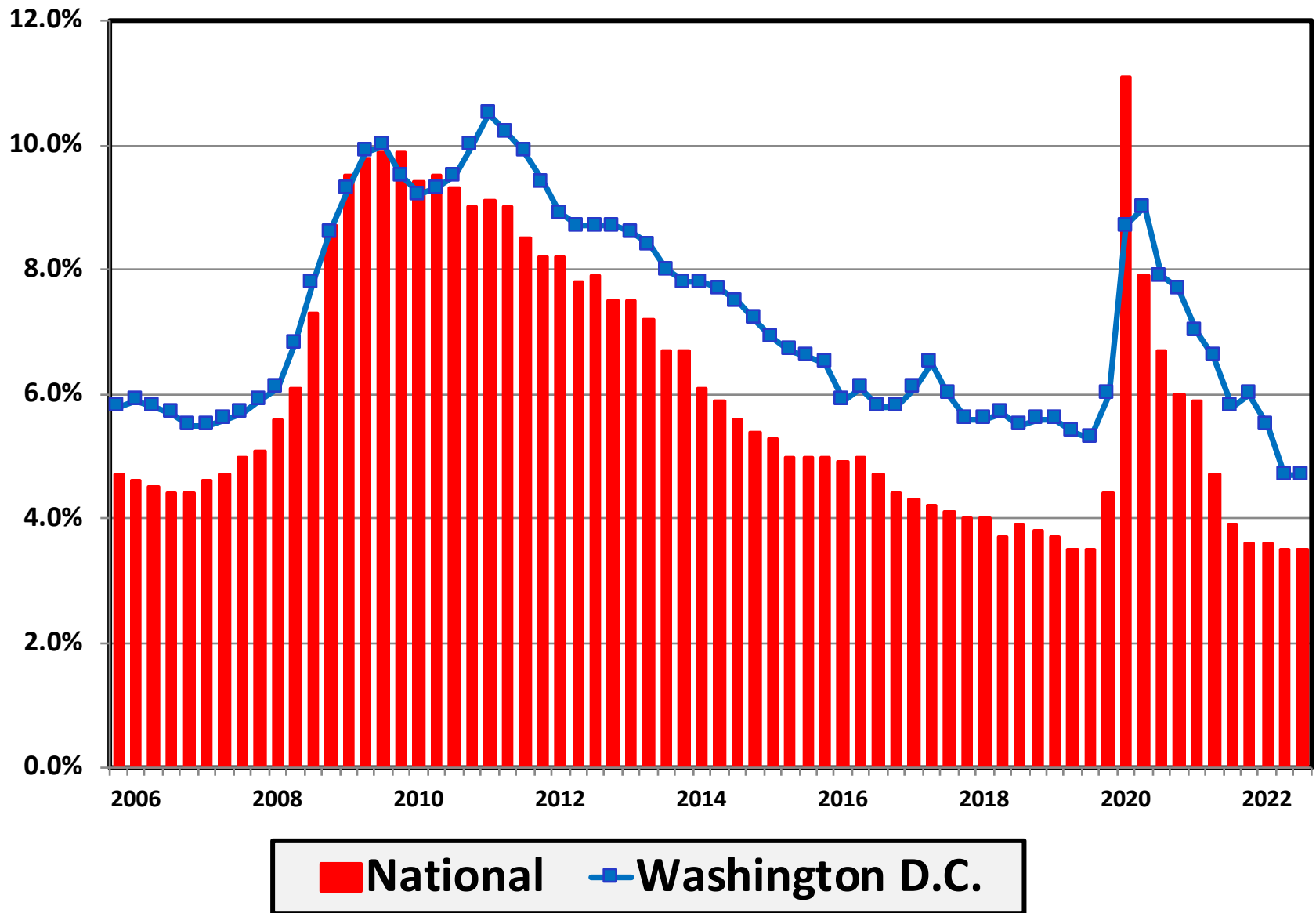

Unemployment Rate By Quarter 2006 - 2022

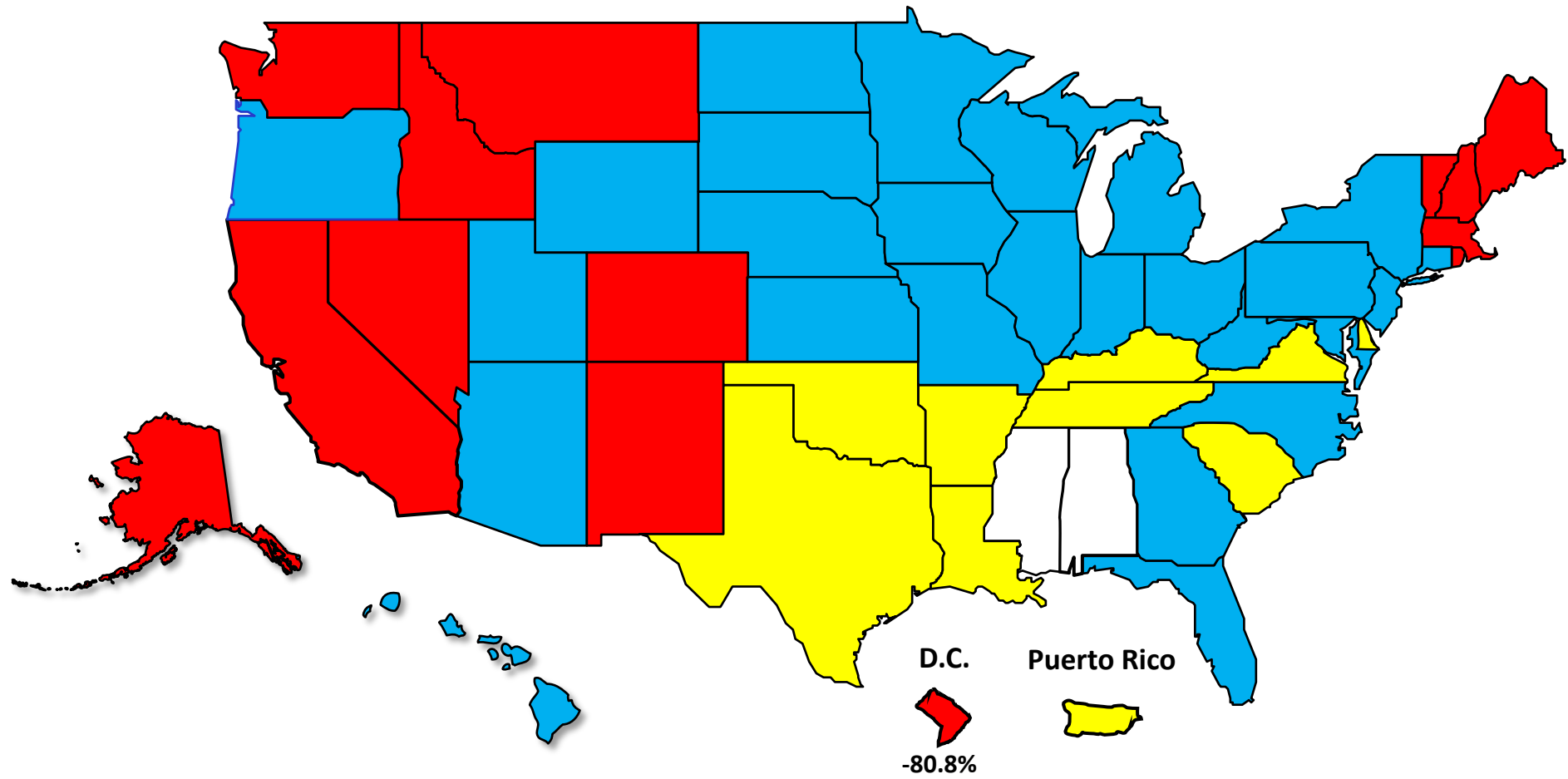

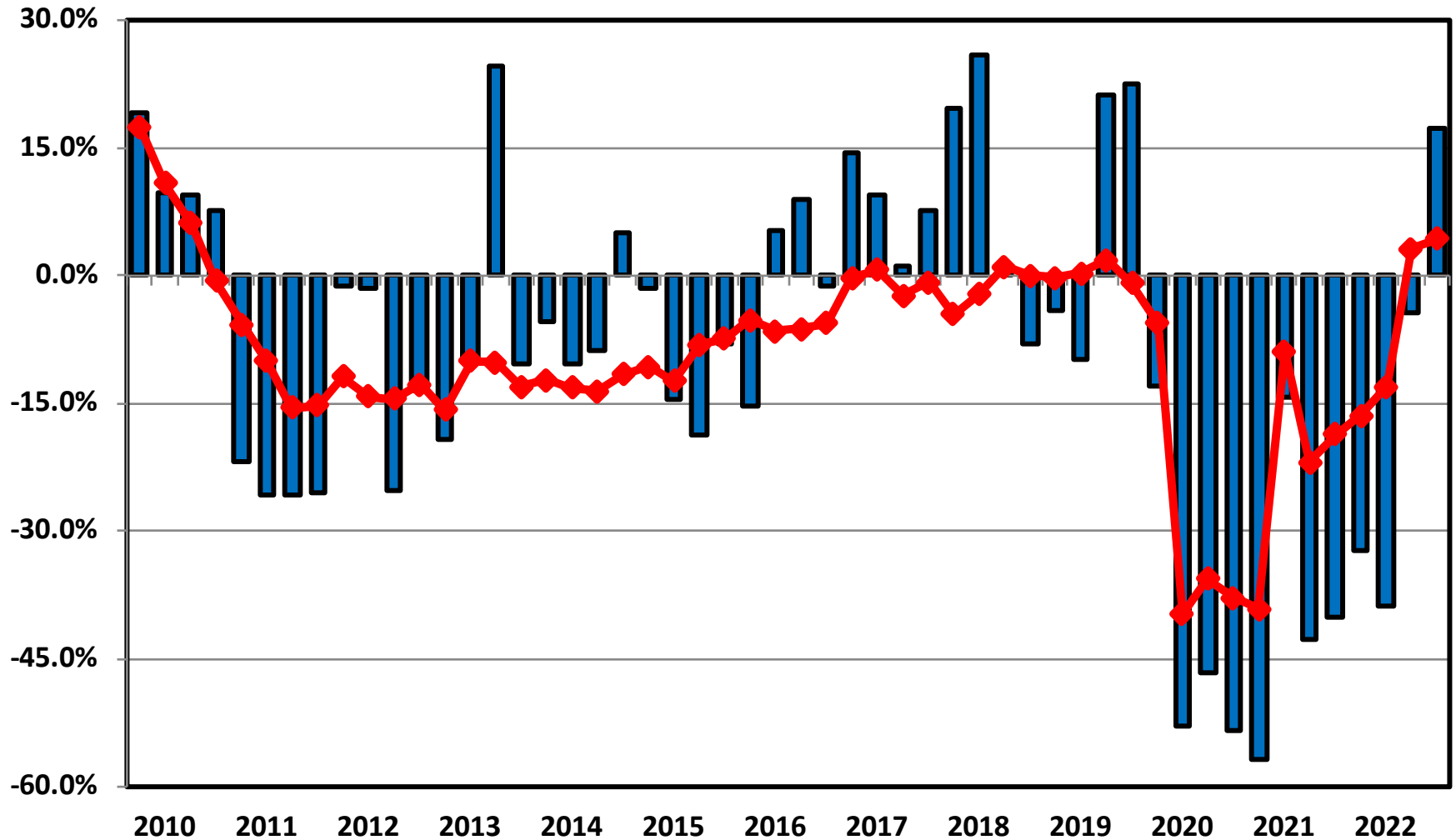
Percent Change in Total Filings Calendar Year 2022 Compared to 2010

Filing Trends By Quarter Washington DC vs. National Average (Percent Change From Same Quarter One Year Prior)

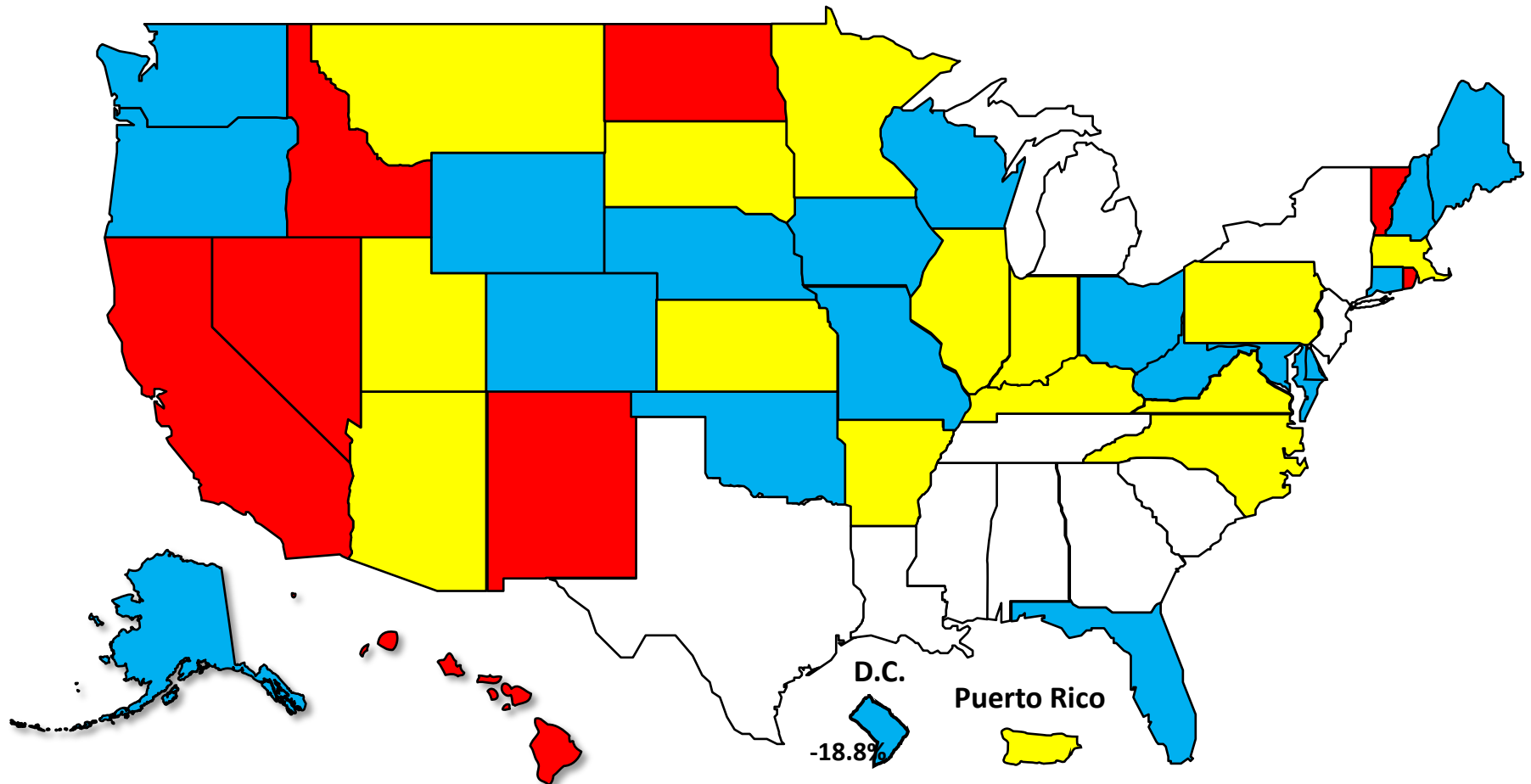
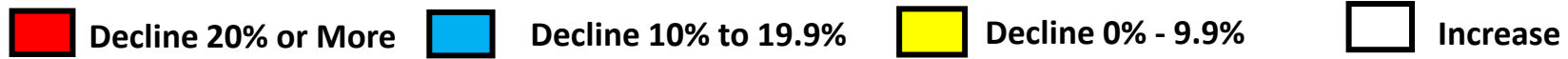

National Average = 6.3% Decrease

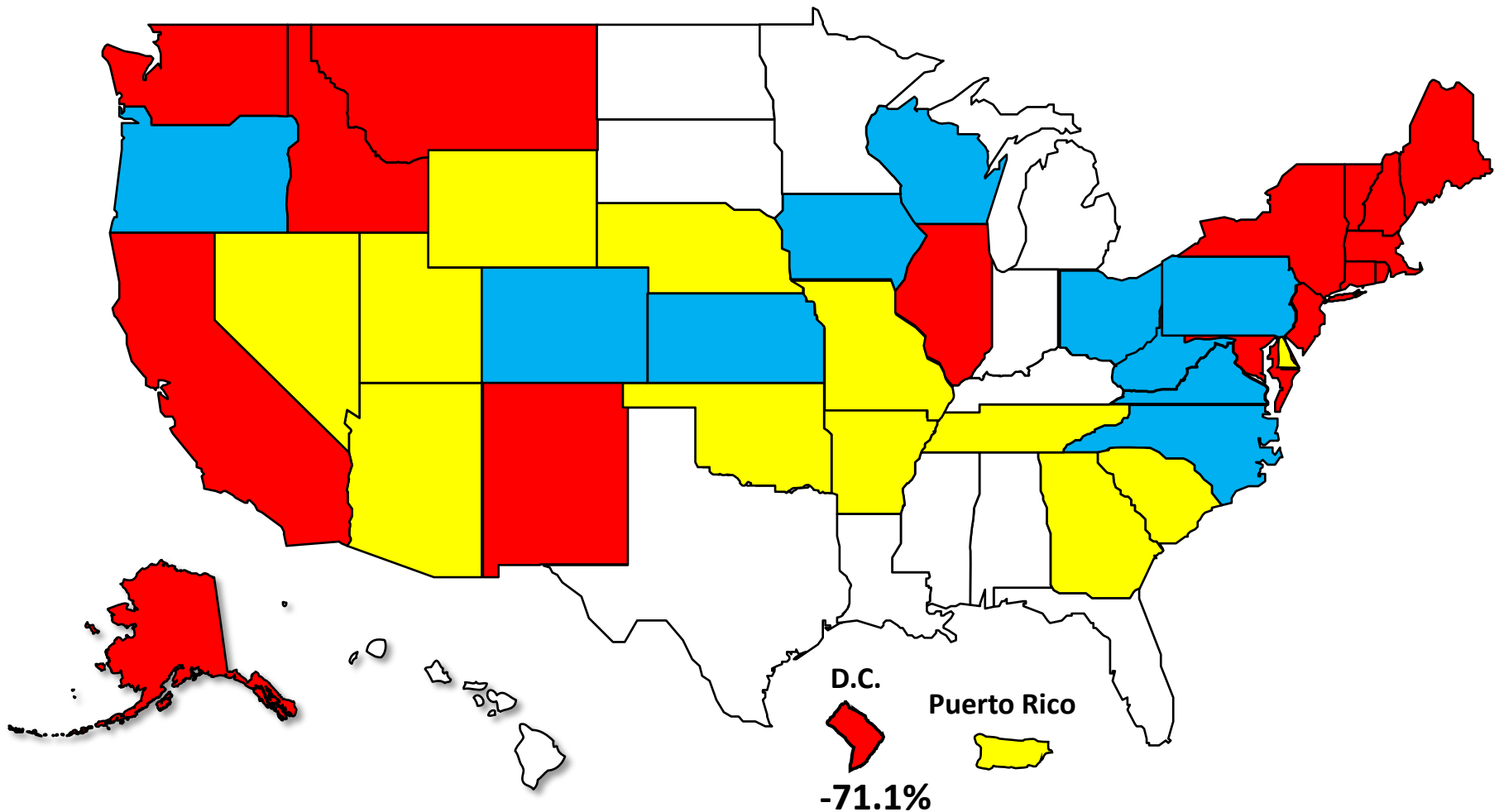


Bankruptcy Filing Trends During the Pandemic
