


The 9,076 bankruptcy cases filed last week were well above the number of filings during the same week in both 2021 and 2022. Bankruptcy filings are now about 60 percent as high as they were pre-pandemic.

Chapter 11 Cases

The total number of chapter 11 cases filed during the week (136) was higher than during the same week each of the last four years. So far in 2023, chapter 11 filings are up by more than 50 percent over the same period in 2022.

The filing by the Archdiocese of San Francisco was the 35th chapter 11 case filed as a result of clergy abuse. This includes seven archdioceses, 25 dioceses and three religious orders. (An archdiocese is generally larger than a diocese and is headed by an archbishop.) About half of the cases have been filed in New York (seven), Minnesota (six) and California (five).
