
Bankruptcy filings are always quite low during New Year's week, and last week was no exception. The 5,386 bankruptcy cases filed last week reflected the lowest weekly total since the first week of 2023.

On New Year's Day, there were 198 chapter 13 cases filed nationwide. More than two-thirds of these cases were filed in either Georgia or Texas. All foreclosure sales in Texas and Georgia are held on the first Tuesday of each month, and chapter 13 filings spike in these two states on the day before.


The following charts show recent weekly filing trends by chapter compared to the same week during the last four years.



## **Chapter 11 Cases**

The 148 chapter 11 cases filed last week were more than double the number filed during the first week of 2021, 2022 and 2023. Excluding related filings by corporate subsidiaries, filings were still well above the same week the last three years, and about the same as were filed during the first week of 2020 (pre-pandemic).
