


The 6,571 bankruptcy cases filed last week were a slight increase over the number of filings during the same week last year, but a little less than the number of filings from two years ago. Filings were down by nearly half from 2019 (pre-pandemic). Chapter 13 cases accounted for nearly half of the filings during the week. Early in the pandemic, chapter 13 cases were only about one quarter of total filings.





## **Chapter 11 Cases**

The 78 chapter 11 cases filed last week were down from the same week the last three years. Nearly half of the cases filed during the week were small business cases in which the debtor elected to proceed under subchapter V.

There were three large or notable chapter 11 cases filed during the week. On Jan. 10, Quotient Limited, a medical diagnostics company, filed in the Southern District of Texas. Pharmaceuticals company Tricida, Inc. filed in Delaware on Jan. 11. On Jan. 11 and 12, beauty retailer Forma Brands, LLC filed in Delaware along with eight related entities.
