
The 9,622 bankruptcy cases filed last week were slightly higher than the number of filings during the same week in both 2021 and 2022. However, bankruptcy filings are still down sharply from pre-pandemic levels.

Other cases filed during the week included 30 chapter 15 cases filed in Delaware by NextPoint Financial, Inc., a Canadian financial services company.





Chapter 11 Cases

Chapter 11 filings were also up from the same week during the last two years. However, excluding filings by corporate subsidiaries, chapter 11 filings were fairly comparable to the caseloads during the same week each of the last four years.

There were two large or notable chapter 11 cases filed last week, both filed on July 27. Aircraft lessor Voyager Aircraft Holdings, LLC filed along with 20 related entities in the Southern District of New York. Strudel Holdings LLC, a holding company that owns Aspen Valley Ranch, filed in the Southern District of Texas along with one related case.

Second Quarter 2023 Filing Statistics Released on July 31

The Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts has released the official bankruptcy statistics for the period ending June 30, 2023. They showed that total filings increased by 10 percent over the previous year and were up by 15.6 percent for the quarter compared to 2022.
