## Weekly Bankruptcy Analysis June 19-25, 2023




The 8,126 bankruptcy cases filed last week were above the number of filings during the same week in 2021 and 2022, but somewhat below the number of filings in 2020 (early in the pandemic). While on the rise from last year, weekly filings are still running well below prepandemic levels.

## **Chapter 11 Cases**

The 77 chapter 11 cases filed during the week represented the second-lowest weekly volume since early January. Excluding related cases, filings last week were fairly comparable to filings during the same week each of the past two years.

There were no particularly large or notable chapter 11 cases filed during the week. However, so far in 2023 at least 80 very large chapter 11 cases have been filed, about triple the volume of such cases filed during the same period in 2022.

## **Bankruptcy Filings on Holidays**

With the addition of the Juneteenth holiday in 2021, there are now 11 official federal holidays. Although the bankruptcy courts are closed on these days, cases can still be filed electronically. Over the last year, filings on most non-holiday business days have been in the 1,400-1,600 range. On six of the federal holidays, filings have been quite low, while on five holidays (Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day and Juneteenth), bankruptcy filings have been only a little below normal levels.
