The 7,781 bankruptcy cases filed last week were above the number of filings during the same week the last two years, but a little below the number of filings in 2020. While on the rise from last year, weekly filings are still running at about only half of pre-pandemic levels.






Bankruptcy Filing Trends (All Chapters) Percent Change From 2022, 2021, 2020 and 2019






Chapter 7 Filing Trends Percent Change From 2022, 2021, 2020 and 2019






Chapter 11 Filing Trends Percent Change From 2022, 2021, 2020 and 2019

Chapter 11 Cases

The 91 chapter 11 cases filed during the week included 19 related filings by corporate subsidiaries. Excluding related cases, filings last week were comparable to filings during the same week each of the past three years.

There were three large or notable chapter 11 cases filed during the week. Sports complex owner Legacy Cares, Inc. filed on May 1 in the District of Arizona. On May 2, drug manufacturer Lannett Company, Inc. filed in Delaware, along with three related entities. Also in Delaware, home goods retailer Christmas Tree Shops, LLC filed on May 5, along with four related affiliates.

First Quarter 2023 Filing Statistics Released

On May 5, the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts released the official bankruptcy statistics for the period ending March 31, 2023. For the year ended March 31, total filings were up by 2 percent over the prior year, chapter 13 filings were up 32.5 percent, and chapter 11 filings increased by 24 percent.


For the quarter, filings were up by 16.9 percent from last year, with substantial increases in filings under chapters 7, 11 and 13. Despite the recent upturn, filings are still extremely low compared to prior to the pandemic.
